Entry fee of \$20 includes: 24 vibrant chalks, Sidewalk square to draw on in downtown Tehachapi and a Chalk on the Walk logo bag. (first 100 entrants only.) Check in after 7:30 a.m. at Gallery 'N' Gifts, 100 W Tehachapi Blvd.

**NO artwork with large areas of BLACK permitted.** (Black chalk stains the sidewalks.)

Squares are not assigned or reserved before drawing begins. Squares are defined by the natural lines of the sidewalk, one square per entry. You may begin drawing anytime but must end by 1:30 p.m. If you arrive early (or even the day before) and have your own chalk you may begin. This allows time for more intricate artwork. Event gift bag and chalk may only be collected at the check in booth after 7:30am on event day. Awards presented at approximately 2:30 p.m. in front of Gallery 'N' Gifts.

Chalk on the Walk is a community-centric event that aims to raise funds through sponsorships. The proceeds are used to purchase art supplies for Tehachapi classrooms. Each artist entry will be judged against its peers. Drawings will be judged based on its composition, color, subject matter, and application of the medium. In each category, an artist/artist group can earn a max score of 5 (lowest is 0). Examples of each category:

- Composition- arrangement of the artwork. Is it balanced? Is it visually striking?
- Color - the color scheme used for the work. Are the colors complimentary to each other? Are there any color blends that show more complexity in color usage?
- Subject Matter - the drawing's theme. Is it family friendly? Is it interesting?
- Application of the medium - the way the chalk is applied. Are the colors solid or streaky? Does it look crisp/clean, or are there a lot of smudges?

Artwork must be appropriate for general public viewing (no objectionable or political subject matter). The committee has the right to "wash you out". Black backgrounds or images with a lot of black are not allowed, it permanently stains the sidewalks. Suggestions: Wear old clothing or protective clothing. Bring a sketch or plan. Bring rags, blending brushes, sponges, gloves, kneeling pad, water, sunscreen, hat, etc. Umbrellas and canopies must be properly weighted down. No stakes are allowed in the grass.
